## **RULES OF CONDUCT**

Recognizing the need to maintain an environment suitable for studying, reading, browsing and general use of library resources, the Library Board establishes the following rules and procedures. These procedures assure the safety of library users, library personnel, and library materials and that patrons may not interfere with the library's use by others by inappropriate behavior or actions:

1. No smoking on library property.
2. No eating or drinking except in designated area.
3. No sleeping.
4. No drunk or disorderly conduct.
5. No harassing library users or library personnel.
6. No pets.
7. No leaving preschool children unattended.
8. No bare feet.
9. No placing feet on chairs or tables.
10. No running.
11. No excessive noise.
12. No damaging of library materials, equipment, or furniture.
13. No removal of library materials from the library without properly checking items out.
14. No cell phone use in the library. If you receive a call, please take it outside or in the small conference room. If you need to use the phone to conduct business while on a computer, please check out a library laptop and do your call and business in the small conference room.
15. No public displays of affection.

Entering the library implies agreement to abide by these rules while in the library. Violation of any one of these rules may subject the individual involved to expulsion from the library for a period of time.
